Go Talk Now is an innovative new AAC app from Attainment Company. The new app offers options for 1-25 buttons per page. You can use images from your iPad camera, photo library, or the built-in internet search and it offers a powerful indevice editor that allows you to crop, scale, and rotate using your fingers! It also features customizable backgrounds. borders, and text can be changed to any color imaginable. You can record your own speech, use text to speech (voices for \$.99 each in over 20 languages), or play videos. Auditory cues can be set to give a brief verbal reinforcement before the selection of the desired button. Go Talk Now! Is also the only app currently on the market that can integrate accessibility scanning using another iPad or an iPod touch and the Attainment Company Switch App. It is a bit pricey at \$79.99 but you get a ton of bang for your buck with this powerful AAC App!
